What is ECHO Autism?

- ECHO Autism is a 6 month experimental research study to determine whether participation in collaborative telehealth intervention will result in improved learning, clinical practice behavior and efficacy among PCPs.
- An innovative system that allows professionals to increase confidence in identifying and treating autism through real time interactions with autism experts.

How will ECHO Autism help me?

- Regular access to Autism experts at CHOP:
 - Autism and Developmental Pediatric Specialist
 - Clinical Child Psychologist
 - Clinical Dietician
 - Resource Coordinator
 - Parent advocate/educator
- Care for your patients in your own practice with the support of nationally recognized autism experts offering opportunities to learn about:
 - Evidence-based practices for screening, diagnosis and treatment of autism
 - Common medical and psychiatric concerns in children with autism through case-based training
 - Successful office visits for children with autism and other behavioral concerns.

How does it work?

- You will be asked to participate in study clinics (including giving case presentations), complete questionnaires, and work with study staff who will be reviewing practice records to measure outcomes of the study.
- Study clinics meet for two hours, twice monthly for 6 months via Zoom (Internet based telehealth program)
- We discuss complex cases in YOUR practice for real-time advice from experts.

What do I need to get started?

- Internet access
- A front-facing camera on smartphone, tablet, or computer/webcam to access Zoom
