



PAFP Chili Cook-Off Entry Form

PAFP will hold its first ever Chili Cook-Off at the Harrisburg CME Conference, March 16-19, 2017. The Chili Cook-Off is sponsored in part by the PA Beef Council. The cook-off will be held at the close of CME and Research Day sessions beginning at 5:15 PM on Saturday, March 18. A limited number of entries are available for Exhibitors, Residency Programs, and FMIGs.

No actual ingredients, equipment, or cooking required to enter in this chili cook-off competition! How easy is that??!! No reason to <u>not</u> enter. No dragging ingredients or cooking gear to the conference; just submit your recipe (one submission per team), create a team/entry name, and you're in! **No entrance fee.**

To submit your entry, complete the below registration form and email it to Janine Owen at <u>JOWEN@PAFP.COM</u> by **Friday, March 3.** You will receive an email confirmation. Note, due to Hilton regulations, no outside food can be brought into the facility to be part of this competition. Chefs at the Hilton will prepare all entries exactly according to your recipe and instructions you provide on the below lines.

All entries will then be presented for sampling and judging by conference attendees during the reception on Saturday beginning at 5:15 PM. Each chili presentation will be labeled with your team name. Teams are required to have at least one representative present at your station. Costumes are not required but encouraged.

A winner will be selected by the team that raises the most donations for the Foundation from conference attendees and guests. Each vote requires a minimum donation of \$1. There is no limit to the number of votes and anyone can vote. Teams are encouraged to campaign and fundraise prior to the event. All proceeds will benefit the PAFP Education, Resident, and Student initiatives. The winning team will be crowned Chili Cook-Off Royalty for the weekend and receive a fabulous prize basket. Additional prizes are available for the most creative presentation.
